technical specifications

- **Access**

Access for van (length: 20 feet - width: 7 feet - height: 9 feet) with parking space nearby.

- **Duration of the show**

13 minutes approx. with possibility of booking up to 3 shows with 30 mn minimum intervals.

- **Public seating**

Audience capacity depends of location and substructures (best arranged in a semi-circle, but a complete circle is also possible).

- **Stage**

- The mast is free-standing and requires a hard, flat surface (not grassy) with a 3% slope maximum.
- Stage area: length: 17 feet (5 m) - width: 17 feet (5 m) - height: 38 feet (min) (11,50 m).
- We do not use pegs, clips, cables or ropes of any kind (the mast is free-standing).

- **Dressing rooms**

- Dressing room with running water, tables and chairs with an access to toilets nearby.
- 2 litres of mineral water per day, available from the very first day for the set up.

- **Setting up/taking down**

- Setting up takes up to 2 hours, depending on the location and taking down the installation takes 1 hour.

- **Equipment provided**

- All props and accessories required for the performance.
- Original sound track on CD or MD.

- **Equipment not provided**

- Sound: A professional-quality audio system, appropriate for the location and 1 CD or MD player.
- Lights: For night shows only, contact us for more details.

- **Technical staff**

- Before the show: 1 person needed for the whole duration of the setting up, 4 additional people to help with the raising of the mast only (10 minutes), 1 sound engineer to set up the audio.
- During the show: 1 sound engineer.
- After the show: Packing up requires the same personnel as setting up.
- For the choice of the location of the pole, think that the sun facing the audience can be embarrassing depending on the time of performance.
